

**Preliminary Notice of Race for Annual No-Frills Regatta
and Florida Regional Qualifier #2**

Organizing Authority:

Melbourne Sunfish Fleet 669 and Melbourne Yacht Club in conjunction with the US Sunfish Class Association.

This notice is to serve as preliminary information for planning only. The official NOR will be published by Aug 15th 2005.

1. Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the rules of the International Sunfish class (except as any of these are altered by the NOR and sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

2. Advertising:

This event shall be a Category A event in accordance with Regulation 20 - ISAF Advertising Code.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

Entry is restricted to members of the Sunfish Class Association. Membership Cards must be presented at registration. All boats must comply with current ISCA rules as published in the 2004-2005 Directory. Boats may be subject to measurement check at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

5. Regatta Entry Fee:

To be announced in the NOR in August. Expected to be \$10 or less.

6. Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in.

7. Regatta Site:

8. **Racing Area** is in the Indian River Lagoon just East of MYC.

9. **Courses** will be published in the sailing instructions.

10. **Scoring** will be the low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the racing rules.
Rule A2 is amended so that each boat's score will be the total of her race scores with no exclusions. Seven races scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

11. Support Boats:

Individual and/or Team Support boats are not permitted. Spectator boats must register with the Regatta Chairman and stay within designated areas.

12. Prizes

Trophies will be provided.

13. Parking

Limited parking is available. Lower lot will be reserved for boats on dollies only.
